RESPONSE RATE

All 193 attendees were contacted the day after the event for their feedback. Another email reminder was sent a week later. The survey link was also posted twice in the TOHDoS Newsletter.

Response rate: 47 / 193 = 24%

HIGHLIGHTS

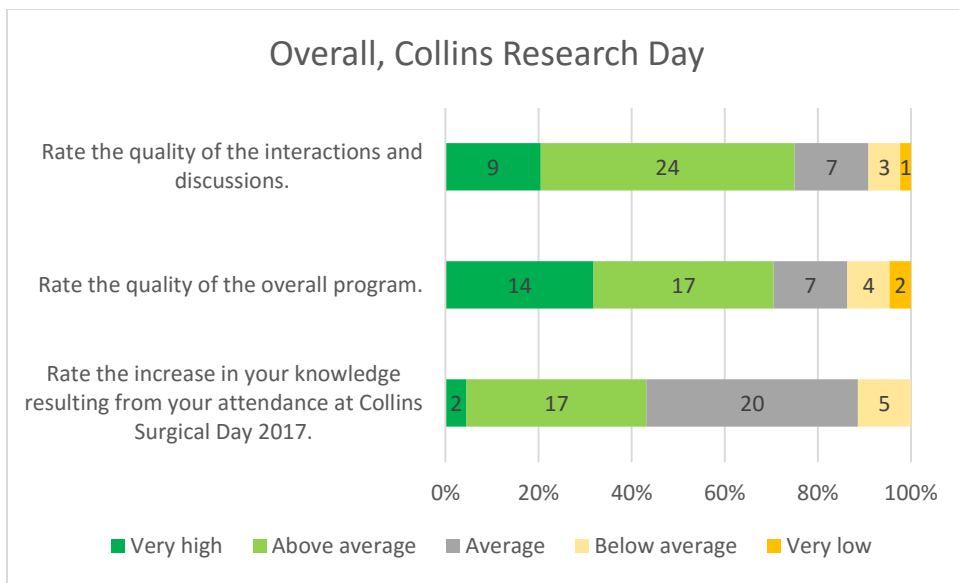
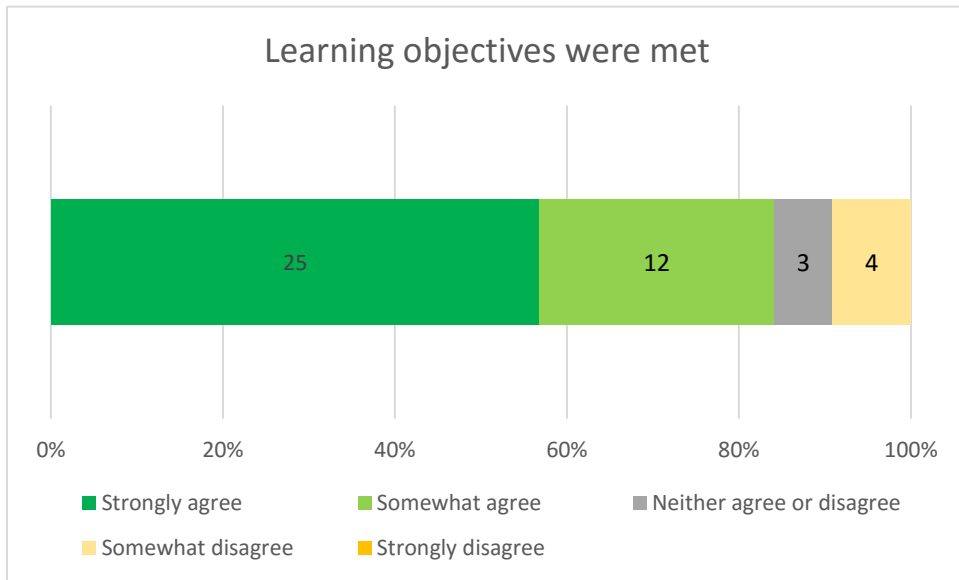
- Respondents agreed that learning objectives were met.

CONCERNS

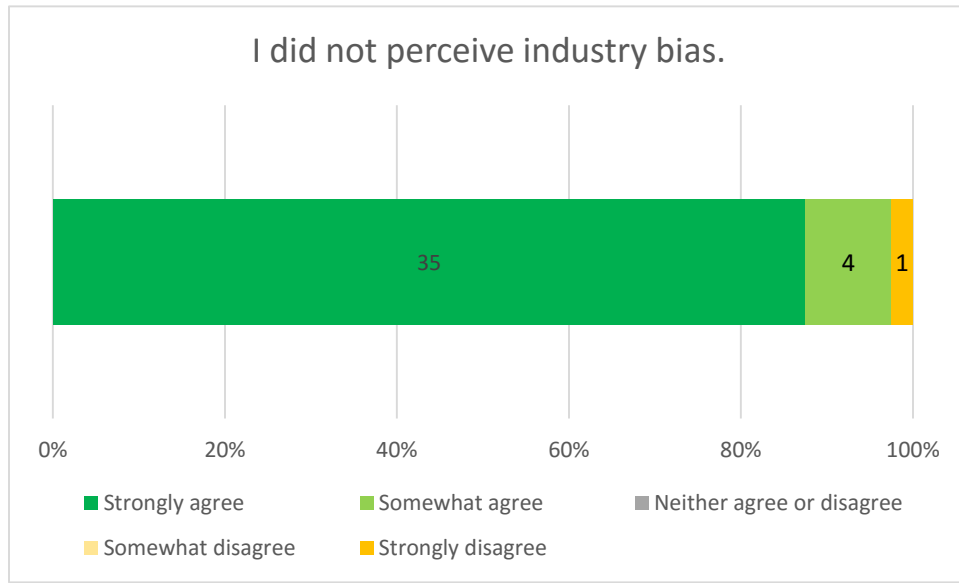
- Quality of the presentations was questioned by some.

OVERALL LEARNING OBJECTIVES AND KNOWLEDGE INCREASE



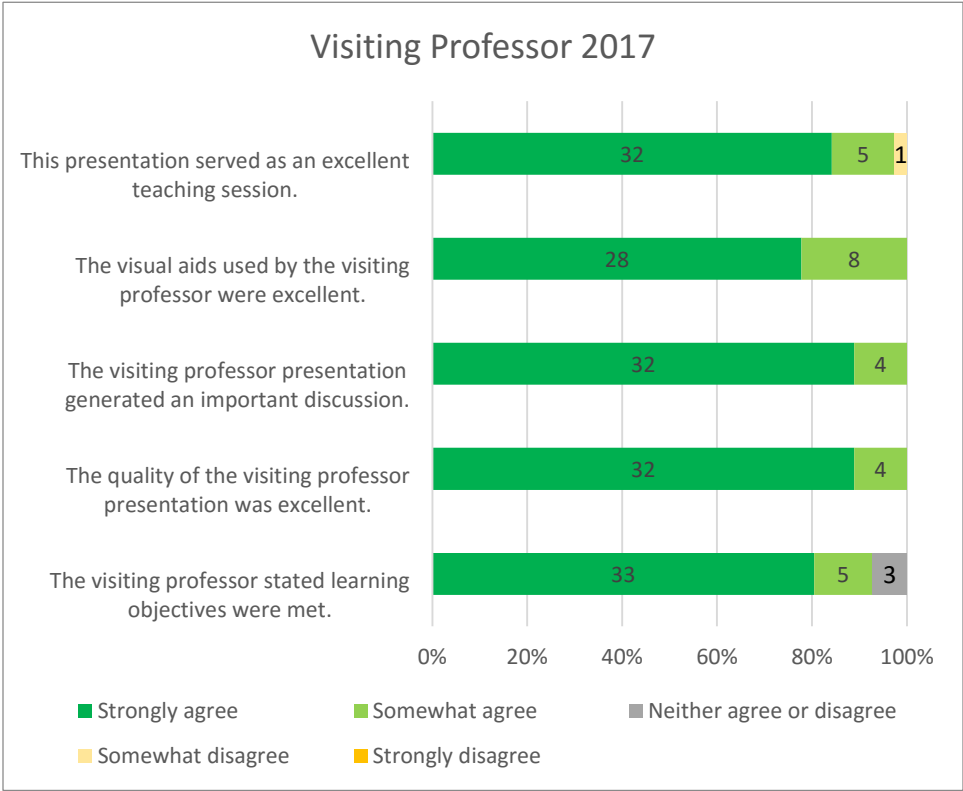
INDUSTRY BIAS AND CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

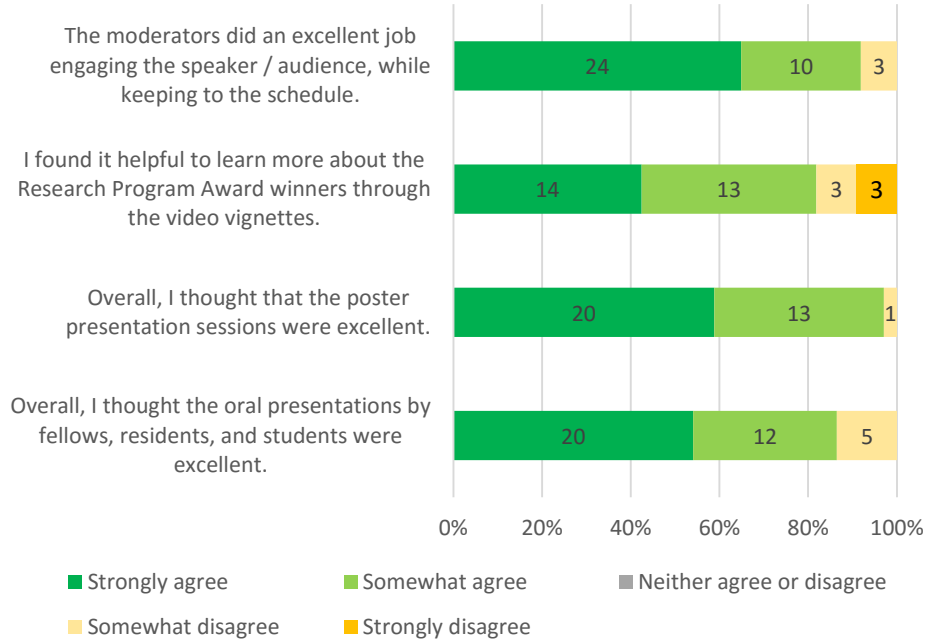

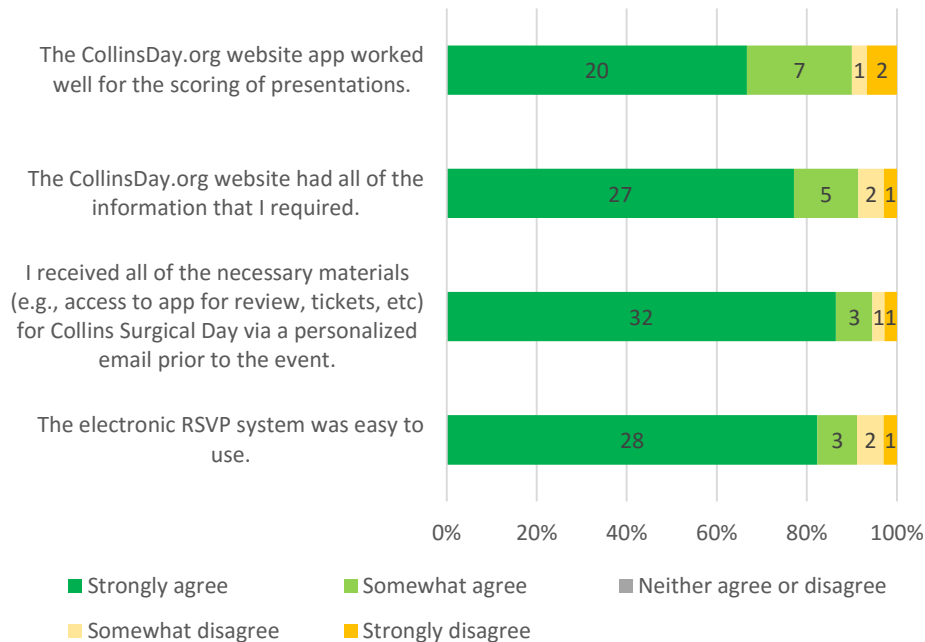


ORGANIZATION OF THE DAY EVENT

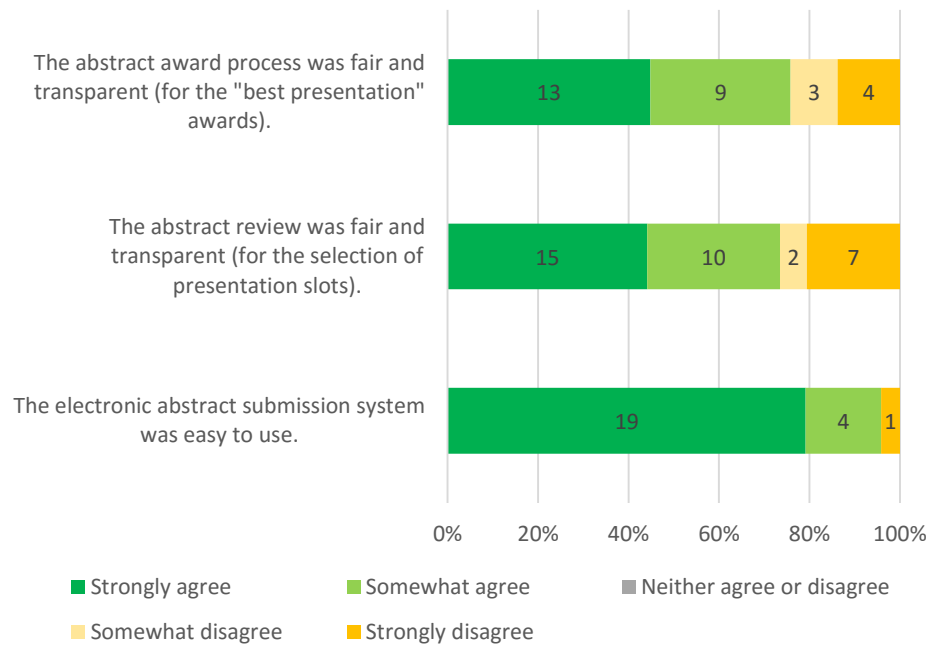
